

10th International Exhibition of
**GLASS SCULPTURE
AND
GARDEN**

**August 27th – September 18th, 2016
Munster, Lüneburger Heide**

Terms of Participation (integral part of the invitation)

1. The international exhibition "GLASS SCULPTURE AND GARDEN" will take place from August 27th – September 18th, 2016, in Munster, Lüneburger Heide, in the Ollershof Garden, the garden of the Örtze "Glass Gallery" and the meadows of the St. Urbani church.
2. The event will be organised by the Town of Munster. During the time of the exhibition, an accompanying programme will likewise take place.
3. An art prize worth € 6,000 will be awarded with respect to the objects shown in the outdoor areas in accordance with the corresponding decision of an independent jury. The prize may be divided between two or more artists. On the occasion of the closing event, an audience award of € 500 will be offered.
4. Each artist may exhibit up to two glass objects in the outside areas and, in addition, up to two small objects in the hall of the town's library or in the St. Urbani Church.
5. The sculptures/objects to be shown must be identical with the respective sculptures/objects indicated in the applications incl. title.
6. The objects to be shown must be predominantly made of glass. They must be composed in such a way that they will be suitable for public outdoor exhibition.
7. The locations for all glass sculptures will be chosen by the artistic adviser, Milan Vobruba. A specific location may not be claimed for any object.
8. The delivery and installation of the objects as well as their dismantling and return transport will be entirely up to the artists themselves.
9. The installation of the glass sculptures will have to be realized from 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 25th, 2016, until 09:00 a.m. on Saturday, August 27th, 2016, and must end at the latest at 10:00 a.m. on August 27th, 2016. A delayed delivery may bring about the exclusion from the exhibition.
The dismantling of the objects will take place from 04:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 18th, 2016, until 04:00 p.m. on Monday, September 19th, 2016.
10. The objects will not be insured. The Town of Munster will not take any responsibility for any damages which may occur.
11. After the end of the 2016 „Glass Sculpture and Garden“ exhibition, each participating artist will receive a travel allowance which will be transferred to his/her respective account. The travel allowance will be graded in accordance with the corresponding country of origin:

- within Germany: € 300.00
- within Europe: € 400.00
- outside Europe: € 500.00

13. The closing date for the receipt of the applications will be December 1, 2015 (date of the postmark).
14. The application must consist of the following documents:
 - Application form duly filled in and signed. Applications without signature will be excluded.
 - Photos/drawings of the objects to be exhibited.
 - Photos of already existing objects from which an assessment will be possible.
 - Curriculum vitae regarding the artistic career (max. 500 characters) and a high-quality photo of the artist (300 dpi, jpg).
15. The exhibition is open to all glass artists. An independent jury will decide until the end of January 2016 which applications will be accepted. The corresponding consent or refusal will be given in writing.
16. A catalogue will be published on the occasion of the exhibition. At the latest until May 1, 2016, photos of the objects must be sent in (by e-mail or by mail). In case a photo will not have been received in due time, the respective object may be excluded from publication in the catalogue.
It is required to submit exclusively authentic photographs of the glass sculptures intended for the outdoor exhibition in print quality or as files (300 dpi, jpg).
Drafts or drawings will not be accepted for publication in the catalogue.
17. With the signing of the terms of participation each participating artist will consent to the publication of the remitted photos as well as his/her personal data (CV, surname, Christian name, street and number, postal code, place, telephone and fax number, e-mail address and data referring to the objects) in printed matters and the media.
18. All artists participating in the exhibition will receive 2 specimen copies each of the catalogue.
19. In case an object shown in the exhibition should be sold, the sale will be handled via the Town of Munster. In order to cover the expenses incurred in connection with the exhibition, the Town of Munster will receive a commission of 25% of the sales price of each sold object. The sales price less the aforementioned commission will be transferred in favour of the artist's bank account indicated in his/her application.
